
The DoD PRCRP provides
\$115M in research funding for 20 eligible cancers



An equitable distribution of funds across the 20 eligible cancers would result in
\$5.8M per eligible cancer



Of the 20 eligible cancers,
9 of 20 are specific cancers in children, adolescents, and young adults



Totaling
\$52.2M for those specific cancers to children, adolescents, and young adults
